Much of the property that has been stolen during the Burglaries has been electrical equipment. Much of these items have no identification mark to assist the Police to trace the owner if later recovered. Please take advantage of the national database scheme as documented under 'Other News' at the bottom of this Newsletter.

What's been happening crime-wise across Bury since the 17th February 2010?



**Burglary Dwelling** - there have been 11 reports of burglary across the Bury Borough.

**M** (Morning 8am -12pm), **A** (afternoon 12pm -10pm), **N** (night time 10pm - 8am) Burglaries have occurred in the following locations:

**Bury**

**Scholes Street** (M/A - offender approaches house from the rear and smashes glass panel in kitchen door. Gains entry to property steals items and exits as per entry.)

**Woodbank Drive** (M - offender approaches property from the rear and forces open patio doors. Enters property and steals items within the house. Offender exits as per entry.)

**Tottington Road** (N - offender enters approaches rear of the property. Smashes bottom pane of glass in the patio door. Enters and steals items. Leaves as per entry.)

**Whitefield**

**Victoria Avenue** (A - offender approaches property from the rear. Forces open kitchen window and enters the property. Steals a number of items exiting via the back door that had the key left in the door.)

**Lancaster Avenue** (M/A - offender approaches house from an over grown front garden. Forces open UPVC door. Enters house and conducts search stealing items. Offender exits as entry.)

**Radcliffe**

**Turks Road** (M/A - Offender approaches house from the rear. Smashes ground floor patio window and enters conservatory. Smashes glass door to enter main house. Steals items and leaves as he entered.)

**Coronation Road** (A - Offender approaches house from the rear and breaks open garden shed removing a spade. Offender uses spade to force open the back door. Enters property and steals items. Leaving as per entry.)

**Woodley Avenue** (A - Offender approaches property from the rear and forces open wooden back door. Enters property and carries out a search stealing items. Leaving as entry.)

**Chestnut Fold** (N/M/A - offender approaches rear of house. Smashes window in the conservatory. Enters the conservatory and steals items. Leaving as entry.)

**Mount Pleasant Walk** (A/N - offender enters garden at the rear of the property. Removes UPVC window enters property and steals items. Leaves as per entry.)

**Bolton Road** (N - offender approaches side of the property and forces open side door. Searches property stealing items. Leaves as per entry.)

If you mark your property it can make it more difficult for a thief to sell on the property and secondly it assists the Police in identifying property that we recover. Immobilise.com is a free online national database that police can access and compare registered items against property that has been found or recovered from suspected criminals so that they can be returned to their rightful owners.

### Partners join forces to improve safety of residents (Bury)

Police have joined forces with the NHS, Bury Council and Greater Manchester Fire and Rescue Service to target crime and improve home safety and security among vulnerable residents.

The partner organisations are working together as part of Team Bury to help make people feel safer in their own homes. The campaign, initially being piloted for three months, will help to identify where home security and safety could be improved through the completion of a quick questionnaire.

For the first phase of the campaign, during routine visits, district nurses will help to identify vulnerable patients who could benefit from the scheme.

With the householders permission a short questionnaire will be completed, and depending on the feedback from the survey, the relevant agency will then take the appropriate action to improve home security and safety. This could include fitting of spy holes, door bolts, door chains and smoke alarms.
